The Committee propose an addition to Section 20 League Format and Rules of Play, Sub-section 2 Match Dates: "If a team fails to fulfil 2 or more fixtures in a season, with a full team of 7 players, then the Committee can immediately suspend that team for the remainder of the season	changes to the rules to cover the following- a. "It was agreed that any team containing less than 6

for the current season to penalise the offending team and protect the integrity of the relevant Divisions and Order of Merits. The team will be relegated in the following season and given notice that failure to fulfil all fixtures in that season will result in disqualification from the league."

than 2 fixtures with only 6 players, then the Committee can at their discretion delete the results from the current season and relegate the team. Rules to be updated

b. The Committee propose an addition to Section 19 Players:

b. Agreed by the meeting –Rules to be updated

If a team fields an ineligible player, then the match has to be conceded and the opposition awarded the 3 points, with an additional 3 points deducted as a penalty in the current season. Should it happen again in the current season or the next season then it will result in immediate disqualification and relegation with all matches voided.

c. The Committee wish to remind all hosting clubs of Section 20.1.5 that states that "the home team will provide a hot meal for both teams." Our interpretation of this is that the meal will be a breakfast / brunch and not just a bacon roll or similar.

d. The Committee have discussed how we could try to make the league matches fairer/closer in terms of the handicap differences between players in matches. Our proposal is we have:

7 players in team as per current rules,

Team positions 1 & 2 can be but do not have to be 5.4 or below,

Team positions 3 to 5 <u>have to be</u> 5.5 to 14.4. Players with a handicap above 14.5 can play in this position but must play off 14.4,

The meeting agreed that the Captains for each match should agree a suitable "meal" ahead of the game as not all clubs have the facilities available for a cooked meal.

- e.The meeting did agree that up to two players with a handicap index of 5.4 could now play in a team Proposed by Martin Whitaker Seconded by Dom James Rules to be update

		A further discussion took place about the number of cards that would qualify a player to be eligible to play in the Sevens League. The meeting agreed that a player was required to submit a minimum of 9 cards in a rolling 12 month period, of which 3 or more must be in a competition.
